

Helping Us Match Your Print Colours

Our digital print machines use **Pantone colour codes** to accurately match colours in your artwork.

The machine operator goes through a process called colour separation to select the main colours from your file.

You can help improve accuracy by picking your **top 3 most important colours**.

Don't want to do it yourself? No problem – our operator will handle the colour separation for you. But sharing your colour choices helps us to print your motifs exactly as you expected.

How to Find Your Pantone Colours

- Step 1:** Go to [Pantone Colour Finder](#)
- Step 2:** Type the colour you want (e.g., “red”)
- Step 3:** On the left-hand side, tick “**Paper TPG**”
- Step 4:** Choose your shade and send us the Pantone name or code

In this example, we searched for a bright red colour—see below
