

Blending Plain Colours Into Prints

For this exercise, we'll show you how to integrate your selected plain colors into your print. This technique can sometimes create a cohesive and harmonious collection, resulting in a stunning, unified design. Other times, the blend might not work as well, but when it does, the outcome is impressive.

For example, if you selected Nero, Pink Punch, Rhuharb, and Marocco as plain colors for your swimwear collection, these are your primary or "predominant colors." Suppose you chose a print called ***Dazzy Daze***, originally in blue, white, nude, and black. Since the print is in vector format (meaning it consists of layers of color), we can easily remove the original colors and replace them with your predominant colors.

Often, your chosen print will have more plain colors than those currently in your collection. This is where your imagination comes into play. Feel free to add additional colors that complement your print. This creative step can elevate your design and make it truly unique.
